

**ACTO Advocacy Goals:  
Litigation, Law Reform, Community Development, Training and Public Legal

*ACTO has adopted the following Advocacy Goals to be applied in determining whether to open new files and undertake new projects. These goals will be considered in determining whether or not to: (i) accept a referral of a legal or other advocacy file from another clinic or other advocacy organization; (ii) provide legal or advocacy advice/assistance to another clinic or advocacy organization; or, (iii) co-counsel or co-organize on a file/project with another clinic or advocacy organization.*

ACTO will focus on litigation, law reform, community development, training and public education work that has the potential to achieve significant and broad change in relation to each of the priority goals set out below.

- A. Achieve greater fairness for tenants living in social housing, including reform of the *Social Housing Reform Act* and regulations**
- B. Make the new *Residential Tenancies Act* (RTA) work effectively to protect the housing rights of low-income tenants**
- C. Make the new Landlord and Tenant Board (LTB) a fair and accessible forum for low-income tenants**
- D. Protect the Affordability and Adequacy of Existing Rental Housing Stock**
- E. Promote Programs to Produce New Affordable Housing**
- F. Reduce Homelessness**
- G. Promote Human Rights in Housing**
